In Literacy...

This week we have been practising the skill of doubling and halving and applying our knowledge into different play situations. We have also been practising counting backwards from different numbers, as well as continuing to work on our number formation. What a busy week!

We have worked on our spelling of words containing the phase 4 quick blends. We have looked at 2 syllable words and practised spelling those too eg, toothbrush, lunchbox. The children have enjoyed finding out how many syllables are in each other's names.
